The Research Scholars in Health Equity program supports the development and refinement of novel and innovative ideas into fundable research projects in health or healthcare disparities. The program pairs aspiring faculty researchers with mentors who have expertise in health equity research, in order to help candidates prepare competitive pilot project proposals for future funding. The program will support the development and refinement of novel and innovative ideas into fundable research projects in health or healthcare disparities. The Diversity Center of Excellence will commit \$25,000 to fund five (1-year) Research Scholars in Health Equity projects (\$5,000 for each project) for our 2020-2021 cohort. Faculty members may apply in teams. Women and underrepresented minorities are encouraged to apply.
